The Federation of Heathfield & St Francis Special School provides for pupils with a range of complex learning difficulties. These may include autistic spectrum disorder, mobility and health needs, communication or emotional and behavioural needs.

We require a BSL level 1 (working towards BSL level 2) Learning Support Assistant to work as a 1:1 for a pupil with a hearing impairment.

The Learning Support Assistant will be required to work under the supervision/direction of the class teacher in supporting the pupil's needs directly or indirectly. This may involve working:

- One to one with a pupil with a HI
- With the specific pupil and another (or others)
- With other pupils to free the teacher for work with the specific pupil
- Working with others while discreetly observing the specific pupil's independent work.
