

Are you E-Safe this Christmas?

Top tips for keeping safe with your devices!

1. Understand what your device can do, whether it is an iPad, Android, mobile phone, PlayStation, Xbox and how you as a parent can support your child to be smart and stay safe!

2. Find out about the parental controls - these will help you to manage your child's gaming and play on their device.

3. Talk with your child about staying safe and being responsible online.

4. Always supervise your children when they are using any device connected to the Internet.

Remember! Do not share any personal information online

Think! Which apps are appropriate for your child?
Have a play yourself so you know what is age-appropriate.

Set up parental controls to ensure that your child is not exposed to any age-inappropriate material and content.

Ensure your child can only download age-appropriate apps: Set the access permissions -

Go to **ALLOWED CONTENT** section and select **APPS**. Then select the maximum age.

Or choose **DON'T ALLOW APPS**
