



### Task 1 – to look at the area where you live

- What is there? Is there a lake/sea/beach/houses/shops?
- What does it look like? Grey/green/sanded/tarmac/fields?
- What plants grow there?
- What animals might you find where you live?
- Do you know what your town is called? What county is it in? What country?
- Look at a map of the world. Can you find the United Kingdom on a map or a globe?

### Task 2 – To learn the 7 continents of the World.

- Look up the following BBC bitesize page and watch the video clips

- Print off the map attached or use an atlas if you have one to find the 7 continents of the world
- Cover the names of the continents with a number from 1 -7. Roll a dice and see if you can name the continent that corresponds to that number. When you have named 1-6 can you remember the last one.
- Print off the globe template and make your own globe. You could make the one that is already coloured or colour your own in using a different colour for each continent.

### Task 3 – To learn the World's oceans

- Just like the land the sea is divided up into 5 areas known as the 5 oceans. Watch the video clip on BBC Bitesize to find out a bit more

- Can you find the oceans on your map of the world and your globe.
- People sometimes use a funny way to remember things such as the names of oceans. It has a funny name, it is called a Mnemonic. You use the first letter of each name of an ocean to make a funny sentence that you will remember eg.

**A**unt     **S**ally     **I**s     **A**     **P**irate.

**(A**tlantic **S**outhern **I**ndian **A**rctic **P**acific)
